



Cocksackie-Athens Central Wall of Honor

The C.A.F.E. established a Wall of Honor as a way to acknowledge and recognize individuals for their achievements as professionals or humanitarians, and those who have made a difference in the quality of life for the Cocksackie-Athens Central School District Community.

Award Nomination Criteria

There are two categories in which persons may be nominated.

1. They must have attended Cocksackie-Athens Schools (either before or after centralization in 1947), proven to be exemplary citizens and have distinguished themselves through their communities or their profession.
This may include service to humanity, exceptional career achievement or a lifetime of accomplishment in many areas.

OR

2. They must have served the school community for 10 or more years by making a significant contribution directly to the Cocksackie-Athens Central School District (either before or after centralization in 1947) beyond contractual obligations.
(Current employees are ineligible.)

Posthumous nominations will be considered.

We prefer typewritten nominations.

4. What honors or awards (if applicable) has this individual achieved?

1. Year of graduation or attendance?
2. What is your relationship with this student? (classmate, teacher, employee, relative, etc.) How long have you known this individual?
3. In what profession, career or other endeavor has this individual made an outstanding contribution? Be as specific as possible.
4. How has this person contributed to improving his or her community?
5. What honors or awards (if applicable) has this individual achieved?
6. In 500 words or less explain why you believe this student deserves a place on the C.A.F.E. Wall of Honor.
